In 2016, the National Bureau of Statistics reported that there were over one million traffic offences, of which 3,500 were fatalities. This year's theme Prevent Accidents. Obey the Law and Save Lives captures the essence of saving lives through responsible driving and adherence to road traffic laws by motorists and pedestrians.
