



GGML Donates Office Furniture Worth Over TZS 160 Million to the Geita Regional Commissioner’s Office



Last week, **Simon Shayo, Vice President: Sustainability and Corporate Affairs (Africa) for AngloGold Ashanti**, visited the Geita Regional Commissioner’s Office for an engagement and donation visit that reinforced our shared commitment to strengthening local institutions.
