Jiendeleze Mchangani Group's Cage Fishing Success

April 2026

GGML, in partnership with the Geita District Council, supported the Jiendeleze Mchangani aquaculture cooperative on Lake Victoria by providing four fish cages, 120,000 fingerlings and 36 tonnes of fish feed.





The 33-member savings group grew its stock to **more than 100,000 fish**, generating harvest income that covers operating costs, builds community capital in Nywala Village and supports a self-sustaining business.





Promoting Safe Mining at the 2026 OSHA Exhibition

April 2026

Tanzania's Occupational Safety and Health Authority (OSHA) hosted an exhibition in Njombe, where GGML engaged hundreds of visitors through presentations on safe mining practices under the 2026 theme, **"Good Psychosocial Working Environments: A Pathway to Thriving Workers and Strong Organisations."**

GGML's commitment to employee well-being was celebrated at the annual OSHA Awards, where the mine received **11 prestigious awards**. Building on its strong performance in 2025, the achievement reflects GGML's continued commitment to a safe, supportive and people-centred workplace.

May 2026

Teachers, parents and guardians in Geita participated in a **two-day Menstrual Health and Hygiene Programme** aimed at strengthening support systems for girls in schools and homes.





Under the theme “**Together for a Period-Friendly World,**” GGML facilitated open conversations, practical learning sessions and a sanitary products donation drive to help break stigma around menstrual and reproductive health while supporting girls’ continued participation in school and community life.

June 2026

In recognition of World Environment Day, GGML joined the Geita Municipal Council, National Environment Management Council, Tanzania Forest Services, local schools and community members for a week of practical climate action.





The initiative combined environmental conservation with practical community action through tree planting activities and the distribution of **240 improved cookstoves**.





Building Safer Communities

June 2026

GGML joined government leaders, the Tanzania Police Force and community representatives to celebrate the **11th anniversary of the Community Policing Programme**, recognising years of collaboration to improve safety in Geita.



Through partnership and community participation, the programme continues to strengthen trust, support crime prevention and enhance local security.





Steps Towards a Malaria-Free Geita

June 2026

GGML supported Geita Municipal Council's malaria prevention campaign through Indoor Residual Spraying (IRS) in **20,000 households** and bio-larviciding across **13 wards**.





With malaria prevalence declining by **over 50% between 2024 and 2025**, continued collaboration through education and practical action between communities, government and partners is making malaria elimination in Geita more tangible.
